

Rating Action: Moody's Ratings upgrades Expand Energy to Baa3

New York, April 16, 2025 -- Moody's Ratings (Moody's) upgraded the senior unsecured notes ratings of Expand Energy Corporation (Expand) to Baa3 from Ba1. We concurrently withdrew Expand's Ba1 Corporate Family Rating (CFR), Ba1-PD Probability of Default Rating (PDR) and SGL-1 Speculative Grade Liquidity Rating (SGL). The rating outlook was changed to stable from positive.

"The upgrade to Baa3 acknowledges Expand Energy's progress in reducing debt since its merger with Southwestern, and expected further deleveraging to achieve its net debt target of approximately \$4.5 billion, aided by attractively priced hedges on a meaningful portion of its natural gas production through 2026," commented Amol Joshi, Moody's Ratings Vice President -- Senior Credit Officer. "Expand's merger with Southwestern completed last year consolidates its scale in some of the core natural gas producing regions and improves its cash flow durability."

RATINGS RATIONALE

Expand's upgrade to Baa3 reflects its considerable scale as the largest independent North American natural gas producer, its improved capital and cost structure upon achieving merger synergies such that the company can generate meaningful free cash flow in a mid-cycle natural gas price environment, as well as the company's expected debt reduction through 2026.

Expand's Baa3 rating is supported by the significant size and scale of its exploration and production operations with a diversified asset base in the premier natural gas focused supply basins in the US. Expand completed its merger with Southwestern Energy Company (Southwestern) in 2024. Expand's leverage metrics are sound and supported by a large and more resilient asset base. The combined company is expected to achieve meaningful debt reduction through 2026 supporting its credit profile. Expand's management team has stated its commitment to targeting net debt of approximately \$4.5 billion and leverage of less than 1x net debt to EBITDAX at midcycle prices. Expand has an active and consistent hedging strategy and has hedged a meaningful portion of its 2025-26 natural gas production, reducing volatility in its revenue and cash flow. The company is also expected to align capital investment with market conditions to optimize free cash flow generation. While the company will likely continue pursuing sizeable shareholder returns including dividends and opportunistic share repurchases, we expect financial strength and flexibility will be maintained and prioritized.

Expand's focus on debt reduction and cost synergies have strengthened its capacity to withstand negative credit impacts from carbon transition risks. The financial performance of Expand will continue to be influenced by natural gas price cycles. As economies transition, global initiatives to limit adverse impacts of climate change will constrain the use of hydrocarbons and accelerate the shift to less environmentally damaging energy sources. Compared to historical experience, we expect future profitability and cash flow across the sector to be more volatile. Expand benefits from being a natural gas producer, given our expectation that natural gas demand will continue to grow longer than oil, though both commodities will face demand peaks followed by gradual decline in the coming years.

Expand should have excellent liquidity to fund its capital budget and dividends through 2026. At December 31, Expand had \$317 million of balance sheet cash, excluding \$78 million of restricted cash. Expand's \$2.5 billion unsecured revolving credit facility was undrawn at year-end 2024. The revolver has one material financial covenant requiring debt to total capitalization not to exceed 65%. Expand has considerable cushion under this covenant, with debt to total capitalization of less than 25% at December 31. The company does not have any near-term debt maturities until its revolver matures in December 2027.

Expand's stable outlook reflects the company's meaningful hedge position and asset integration benefits that should support free cash flow generation and debt reduction through 2026.

FACTORS THAT COULD LEAD TO AN UPGRADE OR DOWNGRADE OF THE RATINGS

Expand's ratings could be upgraded to Baa2 if the company demonstrates that it can sustain a leveraged full-cycle ratio (LFCR) approaching 2.5x and retained cash flow (RCF) to debt exceeding 60% at mid-cycle natural gas prices. For an upgrade, the company should achieve considerable reduction in its finding and development costs to generate more competitive returns on investment and significant free cash flow at lower natural gas prices to enhance its resilience to commodity price volatility. Ratings could be downgraded if Expand generates meaningful negative free cash flow, capital efficiency materially deteriorates, or RCF to debt falls below 30%. Significant debt-funded acquisitions or shareholder payouts could also pressure the ratings.
